 There were no members of the public or written requests.
- 6. To Report Matters Arising from the last meeting The following information was noted:
 - Speeding issues in London Road: update from site meeting 6th July 2022 with West Sussex County Council's Central Area Highways Manager Mr Adam Bazley.
 Mr Bazley advised the Parish Council (email on 29th July) that he will report back once he has received information from the Local Traffic Engineer (LTE) regarding the siting of the terminal speed



limit signs. Clerk will continue to chase for an update to report to the next meeting. Mr Bazley has confirmed that they would be writing to the village pub regarding placement of cones on the highway.

 Community Highways Scheme (CHS) A24/Rock Road Junction Improvements: update on the Parish Council's application from West Sussex County Council's Principal Engineer for Highways Improvements Mr Tom King.

Mr King has informed the Parish Council (email 21st September) that he is reviewing the scheme's on-slip for traffic entering the A24 and has advised that a feasibility study is expected. The Clerk has responded to his queries about the school bus which parks in Old London Road.

11.To Discuss Transport and Planning Issues.

To Consider quotations for a speed activation device in Rock Road

The following quotations were received for a mobile solar-powered speed activation device and one Vehicle Activated Device:

Westcotec:

£7,930 plus VAT - double-facing device to include installation of pre-installed post

Westcotec:

£3,590 plus VAT - single device

Elan City UK:

£2,500 plus VAT- single device recommended by the Committee in June.

Stock Signs:

£2,975 plus VAT - single Vehicle Activated Device.

Spare batteries are an additional cost.

Wilbar Associates: £1,515 plus VAT - estimate for supply and installation of mounting post and traffic management. Fixed quotation on approval of site location.

It was note that the Highways Authority is yet to consider the Council's licence application.

Members considered these quotations. A further option to hire a single device on a trial basis was considered but Members agreed the initial outlay would be too expensive, additional to a permanent installation. They queried the reason why the quotation for a double-facing device was more than twice the cost of a single-one from the same provider.

Following a discussion, the Chairman proposed the following: to enquire if Elan City UK would supply a second speed activation device at the same unit cost, so that traffic speeds could be captured in both directions; otherwise, to recommend Elan City UK's quotation for a single device. **RESOLVED** unanimously to agree the proposals for consideration at the next Full Council Meeting on 7th November.
